#### **School Uniform**

#### **Assessment Week**

We will be carrying out our standardised tests on the week of 8th - 12th May in 1st to 6th classes. Assessments consist of Drumcondra Reading, Drumcondra Spelling and SigmaT (Maths). The results of these tests will be communicated to parents prior to the end of the term. A test is a snapshot of where your child is at and is not a full account of their abilities and learning. A full school report will be issued to parents this term which will be comprehensive in relation to your child's progress in school.
