School Uniform

A reminder also that ***leggings are not part of the school uniform***. Children must wear grey tracksuit bottoms or grey trousers/skirts. Grey leggings are not part of the school uniform. Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing the correct uniform.

Assessment Week

We will be carrying out our standardised tests on the week of 8th - 12th May in 1st to 6th classes. Please ensure your child is in school this week. Assessments consist of Drumcondra Reading, Drumcondra Spelling and SigmaT (Maths). The results of these tests will be communicated to

parents prior to the end of the term. A test is a snapshot of where your child is at and is not a full account of their abilities and learning. A full school report will be issued to parents this term which will be comprehensive in relation to your child's progress in school.


